‘Routing’ instruction

Some questions were only asked of particular groups of people, for example those that answered in a particular way at a previous question, or those who live in a particular geographical region. This is recorded in the notes section of each question (see glossary below), and is incorporated into the frequencies either by a skip code (all those who were not required to answer the question) or by the exclusion of a particular group from the table, i.e. if the question was asked in only in Scotland, then none will appear in the columns table for England and Wales or Ethnic minorities. A list of where the questions asked only of specific groups of people can be found in the code book appears in the appendix.

Frequencies

Each column in the frequency tables includes all the sample for that category, thereby accounting for all respondents. A skipped value has been calculated for those filter questions which did not have a skipped code on the SPSS data file. System missing frequencies were also included where relevant. As such, all columns add up to the following totals, corresponding to the sample from which they were taken.

However, these 106 are also included in the ethnic minority sample, and thus have been effectively counted twice. The England and Wales frequencies for the B/AO questions in the main questionnaire are included in the code book for the sake of completeness.
